Coffee Background

Cubulco is a small town in the heart of Guatemala, located in the department of Baja Verapaz. A high percentage of the population is indigenous, with the majority being of Achi Mayan descent. Altitudes range from 1600 to 1800masl, and small-sized farms dot the highlands. Most farmers employ traditional agricultural practices and operate their own wet mills in the region.

Cubulco is one of Genuine Origin's first community lots, crafted by our amazing quality control lab in Guatemala City. They work with multiple small producers to develop a consistent, high-quality blend every year. The main contributors to the Baja Verapaz Cubulco lot include Las Anonas, Las Naranjas, La Esperanza, Grano de Ora, Finca Las Piedras, and other smallholders. In the cup, Cubulco tastes like dark chocolate, red grape, and orange zest with a bright acidity and medium body.
